# Object Monologue

You will create a **monologue** from the point of view of an object from your house. You could write it down and present it, or write it down and have someone else present it!

<u>Remember</u> A monologue is a speech given by one character. Usually to another character, or the audience:

#### The Monologue:

- Should be at least 30 seconds to 1 minute long (that's about half a page to a page long - one sided).
- Could be presented with a video or just a sound recording.
- Should talk about the following ideas.

### The Ideas

- 1. :What would this object say if it could talk and wanted to tell us about its history?
- 2. Where has it been? What it has done?
- 3. The object should tell us about it's past, present and also it's hopes for the future.
