Professional Development (PD) - Training for teachers and/or administrators that enables staff to learn more about developing arts-based lessons and best practices; often customized to specific classroom interests and goals.

Field Trip (FT) - A classroom visit to a cultural institution, museum, or external arts partner's facilities for an arts-related educational experience or performance.

Resources (RESO) - An external provider supplies physical resources to supplement a school's arts education programming (e.g. arts supplies, instruments, etc.). Do not include grants or granting agencies as partners.

Other (O) - Services not captured in the abovementioned categories (e.g. parent and community programs and classes, planning services, and hosting exhibitions and competitions.)
